RESOLUTION NO.: SL-09-2011

TITLE: Approval of 2011 Bureau of Indian Affairs Range Noxious Weed Funding

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to Section 16 of Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 08, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Council; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has the responsibility for the general welfare of its tribal membership including tribal natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council is the duly constituted governing body within the boundaries of the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has been organized to represent, develop, protect and advance the views, interests, education, resources, and general welfare of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe membership; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has organized a Natural Resource Department to provide technical expertise and services to manage air, water, soil, fish, wildlife, and plants within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation and off-reservation areas considered the aboriginal homeland of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council supports management to protect, conserve, and enhance plants and wildlife endemic to the Summit Lake basin and aboriginal area of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe submitted a grant proposal to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for \$30,125 and received \$9,938 in funding for noxious weed control in 2011; and . Subsequent funding for this fiscal year and any extensions of this grant are included in this Resolution.

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe understands subsequent funding for fiscal year 2011 and any extensions of this grant shall be authorized by this Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Paiute Council approves the use of \$9,938 awarded by the BIA for control of noxious weeds in 2011 as detailed in a Statement of Work dated April 16, 2011, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Paiute Council approves the use of subsequent funding awarded by the BIA for control of noxious weeds in 2011, and should the award come late in the season, the funds may be used for noxious weed control in additional years, as authorized.
