RESOLUTION NO.: SL- 06 -2010

TITLE: Update and Correct Designation of Roads in the Indian Reservation Road System for the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to Section 16 of Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 08, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Council; and,

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe's Articles of Association grant to the Summit Lake Paiute Council (see Article II, Section I) certain sovereign powers, including the power to seek funding from Federal agencies like the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) to improve the welfare of tribal members (see Article II, Section 1 (b), (k)); and,

WHEREAS, approving a road inventory update improves the welfare of tribal members; and,

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council (Council) enacted Resolution SL-03-2009 to update the designation of roads in the Indian Reservation Road (IRR) system for the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and

WHEREAS, Resolution SL-03-2009 requested the BIA to update a map and remove erroneous emblems for BIA Routes, County Roads, and the names "Soldier Meadows Road", "Badger Mountain Rd", and "Denio Rd" until further notice from the Council; and,

WHEREAS, during the process to approve the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Road Repair and Restoration contract CTH61T655U6 it was discovered the project plan map contained errors designating Routes 1 and 2.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Summit Lake Paiute Council, the governing body of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe, hereby request three BIA Routes as part of the IRR system be established on the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation as delineated on the attached map with the following names: BIA Route 1 existing on the west portion of the Reservation and

orientated north and south shall be named the Gerlach Road; BIA Route 2 existing north of Summit Lake and orientated west to east shall be named the Cedarville Road; and BIA Route 3 existing on the northeast portion of the Reservation, north of the intersection with BIA Route 2 shall be named the Denio Road.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby authorizes the BIA-Western Regional Office to take the necessary action needed to update BIA Division of Transportation IRR System database to incorporate road inventory update changes, section designations, and additions identified on the attached map.


