RESOLUTION NO.: SL - 16 - 2009

TITLE: RECONTRACT THE CONSOLIDATED TRIBAL GOVERNMENT PROGRAM, CONTRACT # CTH61T655U1 FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2010

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe, is a modern entity of the Northern Paiute People known, in English, as Lake Trout and Wild Onion Eaters who, for thousands of years, controlled at least 2,800 square miles of land in and around Summit Lake as a tribe with sovereign, unlimited, powers and laws (customs, traditions, usages, etc.); and,

WHEREAS, in 1964, and after much consideration, the members of the Lake Trout and Wild Onion Eaters organized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, adopted, for certain sovereign purposes, the name "Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada" with a tribal constitution titled "Articles of Association," the latter which was approved by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of the Interior on January 8, 1965; and,

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe's Articles of Association grant to the Summit Lake Paiute Council (see Article II, Section 1) certain sovereign powers, including the power to negotiate with federal agencies like the U.S. Department of Interior and others and their respective departments and agencies to improve the welfare and education of tribal members (see Article II, Section 1 (b), (k)); and,

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe has, in the past, received funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, pursuant to Public Law 93-638, to provide Consolidated Tribal Government services under the Tribal Priority Allocations for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribal Council has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Tribe, to Re-Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Consolidated Tribal Government Program for FY 2010, to continue to provide Aid to Tribal Government, Indian Child Welfare Act, and Enrollment services for the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Summit Lake Paiute Council, the governing body of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada, hereby submits to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Re-Contract application for the Consolidated Tribal Government Program Contract, pursuant to Public Law 93-638, with the following terms and conditions:

1. The Tribal Officials authorized to submit, negotiate, and execute the contract and any amendments thereto, shall be the: Council Chairperson; Council Secretary/Treasurer; Acting Chief Administrative Employee; and or, the Natural Resources Department Director.
2. The authority granted by this resolution shall remain in effect until such time the contract is closed out.
3. The contract date of the Consolidated Tribal Government Program Contract will be from January 01, 2010 through December 31, 2010.
4. The Council Chairperson, Council Secretary/Treasurer; Acting Chief Administrative Employee; and or the Natural Resources Department Director are authorized to make any and all necessary expenditures consistent with the intent of the proposed contract, in accordance with the Fiscal Policies and Procedures of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada.
