

RESOLUTION OF THE SUMMIT LAKE PAIUTE TRIBAL COUNCIL
OF THE
SUMMIT LAKE INDIAN RESERVATION, NEVADA

Resolution No. : SL-15-2007

TITLE: Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada; Electing to Participate in the National Sex Offender Registry System.

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe hereafter "Tribe" in organized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Self Determination Act of June 1934 (48 Statute 984) as amended with Article of Association of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe approved the Secretary of Interior on June 08, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Tribal Council, hereafter "Council"; and

WHEREAS, the Council is authorized pursuant to the Articles of Association of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; Article II, Section 1 (j), to determine its own rules of procedure; and (k), to take actions as are necessary to carry into effect any of the foregoing powers and duties; and

WHEREAS, in Accordance to Article II, Section 1 (b) to represent the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe in negotiation with Federal, State, and local government, and other corporation, associations, partnerships or individuals, and to cooperate with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Department of Public Health, and various departments and agencies of the State of Nevada in matters of welfare, education, recreation, and social services; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada, has a compelling interest in promoting public safety on tribal lands and protecting tribal citizens from violent crime; and

WHEREAS, The Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada, also has a compelling interest to protect tribal sovereignty and tribal jurisdiction over tribal lands; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada elects to participate as a registration jurisdiction in the National Sex Offender Registry system as outlined in Section 127 of PL 109-248.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada intends to seek funds from the Department of Justice under the Sex Offender Management Assistance Program authorized by PL 109-248.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada does not consent to any exercise of state jurisdiction on tribal lands under the National Sex Offender Registry System.
