RESOLUTION NO. SI-⁹2007

TITLE: INDIAN NATIONS CONSERVATION ALLIANCE (INCA)

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to Section 16 of Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 08, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribal Council is the duly constituted governing body within the boundaries of the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribal Council has been organized to represent, develop, protect and advance the view, interests, education, resources, and general welfare of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe membership; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribal Council recognizes the importance of addressing Food, Agriculture and Natural Resource needs on the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation through the utilization of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) programs and other federal programs and technical assistance and to increase opportunities for Indian farmers and ranchers to own, operate and retain farms and ranches; and

WHEREAS, the technical and cost-share assistance provided by the USDA is most effectively provided through a Tribal district's leadership and Long Range Natural Resource Plan; and

WHEREAS, a Summit Lake Tribal District will have the authority to work with other cooperating agencies, Tribal Natural Resource Specialists, Tribal Natural Resource Boards and any other parties interested in the development of a Natural Resources Long Range Plan for the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe which will establish priorities under which the USDA agencies will function under on the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Tribal Council hereby establishes the Summit Lake Tribal Conservation District, defined by the exterior boundaries of the Summit Lake Reservation and authority of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe will enter into a mutual agreement with USDA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Tribal District is empowered to enter into Cooperative Working Agreements with the USDA agencies and other cooperating agencies, with the approval of the Summit Lake Tribal Council, to carry forth the Tribal Districts Long Range Natural Resources Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Tribal District will develop and implement By-Laws for establishing and governing the Summit Lake Tribal District Board of Supervisors.
