RESOLUTION NO.: SL- 02 -2013

TITLE: APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF UPDATED NONPOINT SOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe, is organized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 08, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Council; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has the responsibility for the general welfare of its tribal membership including natural resourced; and

WHEREAS, over time the members of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe have regained a small fraction of their historic land base, including the Tribe's reserved lands (Reservation), and the Indian allotments outside the Reservation boundaries; and,

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council is the duly constituted governing body within the boundaries of the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has been organized to represent, develop, protect and advance the views, interests, education, resources, and general welfare of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe membership; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has organized a Natural Resources Department to provide technical expertise and services to manage air, water, soil, fish, wildlife, and plants within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation and off-reservation areas considered the aboriginal homeland of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; and

WHEREAS, it has been found that the most recent version of the Nonpoint Source Assessment and Management Plan for the Reservation approved in 2010 contained several typographical errors and incorrectly listed the lengths of Mahogany and Snow Creeks within the Reservation boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Department of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe has corrected these errors, as well as incorporated new information regarding recent actions to minimize nonpoint source pollution on the Reservation and consequently finds it necessary for the Summit Lake Paiute Council to

formally adopt these changes to the management plan to guide department activities, priorities, and decisions.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Paiute Council approves this update of the 2010 Nonpoint Source Management Plan presented by the Natural Resources Department and adopts this document for the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe.
