**RESOLUTION NO SL-01-2007**

**TITLE:** Contract between the law firm of Hobb, Straus, Dean & Walker, LLP and the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe.

**WHEREAS,** The Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 ( 48 stat. 984), as amended with the articles of association approved by the Secretary of the interior on January 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS,** The Summit Lake Paiute Tribal Council (hereafter) Council, is authorized under the Article of Association as the governing body of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** Article II Section 1, (d) of the Article of Association ("Article") of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has the power employ legal counsel, the choice of counsel and fixing of fees to be subject to the approval of the Secretary of the interior, and

**WHEREAS,** Article II Section 1, (k) of the Article, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has the power to determine such action as are necessary to carry into effect any of the forgoing power and duties; and

**WHEREAS,** The summit Lake Paiute Council deems it to be in the best interest of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe to employ the law firm of Hobb, Straus, Dean & Walker, LLP for legal counsel upon terms of the Tribe General Counsel Attorney Agreement attached hereto; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby approves the execution of the attached Tribal General Counsel Attorney Agreement with the law office of Hobbs, Straus, Dean & Walker, LLP.
