At 11:00am in Carson City, Nevada Council Vice-Chairwoman Delgadina Gonzalez and Council Member Jerry Barr met up with Betty Aleck, Pyramid Lake Museum Care-taker and Dean Barlese, Spiritual Advisory along with Reno/Sparks Indian Colony Spiritual Advisor Bucky Sampson and son, Carl Sampson.

At 11:30am Spiritual Advisors and helpers loaded remains to vehicles and traveled to Pyramid Lake Museum.

At the 1:00pm arrival at Pyramid Lake Museum, Spiritual Advisors and helpers unloaded and took inventory of remains. At this time, Orville Barlese, Keenan Reed, Robert Lowery and Ken Paul, Spiritual Advisors, joined the group and the Prayer Ceremony began with a history and discussion of where the remains were found. The remains and belongings were properly prepared for re-burial at the Summit Lake Reservation on Wednesday, November 21, 2014.

Approximately 3:10pm Council Vice-Chairwoman Delgadina Gonzalez and Council Member Jerry Barr returned to Primary Administrative Office to return tribal vehicle.
