The proper burial preparations and Prayer Ceremony were conducted at the Pyramid Lake Museum in Nixon on Monday, November 17, 2014.

On Friday, November 21, 2014, Vice-Chairwoman Delgadina Gonzalez, Council Secretary/Treasurer Elizabeth DeLaLuz, Council Member Jerry Barr, Council Member Page Linton, Summit Lake Maintenance Worker Orville Barlese and Community Spiritual Advisors transported the remains to the Summit Lake Reservation for the re-burial of ancestor bones and personal belongings.
